CHANGES TO THE COMMISSION'S WEBSITE - POLICY STATEMENTS AND GUIDANCE NOTES PAGES

The Commission has revised the way in which its Website is set out in relation to Policy Statements and Guidance Notes. These documents previously had separate pages and have now been combined in a single Policy Statements and Guidance Notes page to aid navigation and website maintenance.

This single page (please [click here](#)) is sub-divided into two categories:

1. "General Application" - documents which have general application and may be of interest to all persons; and
2. "Sector Specific" - documents which relate to entities regulated by the Commission under one of the four Supervisory Laws¹. Colour coded dots have been used to indicate the business category or categories to which each document relates.

Each document has also been coded with PS and/or GN to indicate which type of document it is. A guide to the coding is available at the top of the page.

In addition to the single Policy Statements and Guidance Notes page there are also sector specific Policy Statements and Guidance Notes pages which replace the individual Policy and Guidance Notes pages previously available from the Divisional Dropdown menus on the Website. To access these sector specific pages please use the "Blue bar" at the top of the Webpage to navigate the Website.

Any old pages have a redirection service to prevent any "quick links" or "bookmarks" you may have from breaking. This service will run for one month, so please ensure that any "quick links" or "bookmarks" are updated.
